There's Always Room at His Table

In 1985, Scott Macaulay was 24 years old. His parents had just gotten a divorce. The adjustment was hard enough in and of itself, but it became more pronounced as Thanksgiving rolled around. *"What's going to happen at Thanksgiving? ... I just did not like the thought of being home alone—or anywhere alone—on Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is not about gifts or fireworks or hoopla. It's a meal around a table where you give thanks for the blessings you have, and you really can't do that by yourself and have much fun."*

So Scott found a creative way to fill his home and his life with gratitude. *"I decided to put an ad in the local paper: If people thought they would find themselves alone, they could give me a call, and I would make a Thanksgiving dinner."*

That first year, only a few people showed up. But Macaulay was committed to the "thanksgiving". *"I've held the dinner every year since. Last Thanksgiving, 84 people showed up."*

For Macaulay, says writer Dave Isay, *"There's always room at his table."*

God longs to gather everyone to His table of thanksgiving, so He sends us out to invite the whole world to come, not for a day, but for an eternity. There is always room at HIS table.
