Fix Your Eyes

I remember when I was a kid I used to look at the "magic eye" in the newspaper. Remember that? The colorful image where you had to gaze at it long enough until a picture emerged. I would always ask the same friend if he saw the picture in the magic eye. I would say, "There! See it? It's a duck!" Or, "See! Right there! It's a rocket ship." But all he could see was a green blurry shadow.

Years later, my friend found out he was color blind. What most people don't realize about color blindness is that it is not the absence of colors for most people. Colorblind people just see the colors differently than everyone else. So they could never see a magic eye because they are focused on the wrong colors.

The writer of Hebrews tells us in Hebrews 12:2 to "***fix our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith***". The trouble is that we are fixated on our problems. We strain at our worries, our doubts, our imperfections, and even our sins. As these things capture and keep our focus, we lose sight of Jesus.

In order to see Jesus in the blurry mess of life, we must focus our attention on Him. As we focus on His person, His victory, His promises, His faithfulness, we begin to see Him in everything, even in the problems we face.
