Jesus Saves

In October 2019, Tyler Moon took part in a 10-mile race in Minneapolis. Wanting to declare his faith openly, Moon decided to put "Jesus Saves" on his race bib hoping to inspire someone in the crowd. Instead, the bib's message would prove to be true that day.

The 25-year-old had a heart attack and collapsed around mile 8 of the race. About a dozen people rushed to help him, administering CPR and calling an ambulance. Among them, a runner named Jesus Bueno, a certified registered nurse. He was one of the first to reach Moon and to help save his life.

"Jesus Saves" is a popular slogan. We see it on bumper stickers and on signs at athletic events. I often wonder if people who see that phrase really know what it means. It means that Jesus suffered and died on a cross to save us from our sins. It also means that to be saved we must accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, placing our faith and trust in him alone for our salvation.
