Clubhouse vs. Lighthouse

"A Southern California minister reports a neighboring church had just completed a large addition, including a new sanctuary, to house their growing congregation. They then discovered that 250 housing units were going in right behind them—they would share a property line.

Their minister said he had two conversations within a three-hour time period. The first individual said: 'We need to build a fence so their kids don't wander onto our property.' The second person asked: 'Do we have the money to build a sidewalk and steps up to our church so their kids can come to our ministries?'"

This is an old struggle in churches that have gone from being a lighthouse for the lost to becoming a clubhouse for the saints. This tension is created when the spiritual needs of the lost come into conflict with the comfort of those who have found the Lord. Given the far greater need of the lost, it is necessary for the believer to give the greater priority to reaching the lost.
