Words of Life

“Words with Friends”, a popular Scrabble-like game played by millions on smart phones and Facebook, is being credited with saving the life of an Australian player’s spouse. Georgie Fletcher was playing “Words with Friends” on her smart phone recently with Beth Legler, a woman living a half a world away in Blue Springs, Missouri, when Georgie's husband Simon began complaining of not feeling well. She described his symptoms to Beth, who relayed them to her husband Larry, who happens to be a medical doctor. Larry advised that Simon seek medical attention immediately. Turns out, Simon was on the verge of a heart attack, with a 99% blockage of a major blood vessel very close to the heart. Delay in treatment could have proven fatal.

“I owe Larry everything,” Simon said, “I’m really lucky to be here.”

Truth is, we play “Words with Friends” every day—not on our iPhones or on Facebook—but in all of our real-life interactions. Harsh words can tear a soul to shreds. Kind words can sooth a broken heart. Words of spiritual encouragement can steer someone away from sin, and can even lead an unbeliever to Jesus. Words have the power to harm and the power to heal. The right words at the right time can save a life.
