A WORD FROM BRUCE

A college student who had always lived in the city was visiting a ranch in Texas. She was fascinated by all the animals. She had never seen so many before so it wasn't unusual when she blurted out, "What an unusual looking cow. Why doesn't she have any horns?"

The rancher explained, "Well, some cows are born without horns and never have any. Others shed theirs, and some we dehorn. And some breeds aren't supposed to have any horns at all.
