## **COST OF FREEDOM**

On June 11, 1776, in Independence Hall in Philadelphia, men from each colony gathered to frame the Declaration of Independence. Twenty-four were lawyers and jurists. Nine were farmers and land owners.

They understood the risks involved. If they won, they could expect years of hardship in a struggling nation. If they lost, it meant the hangman's rope. They stated: "For the support of this Declaration, with the firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes, and our sacred Honor..."

Of the 56 men who signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, five were captured by the British and tortured before they died. Twelve had their homes, from Rhode Island to Charleston, sacked, looted, occupied by the enemy or burned. Two lost their sons in the army. One had two sons captured. Nine of the 56 died in the war, from its hardships or from its more merciful bullets. They were men of means, who enjoyed much ease and luxury in their personal living: yet, they considered liberty more than security.

They fulfilled their pledge. They paid the price and we enjoy the fruits of their labors and sacrifice.
