EVER WONDER WHAT TO SAY?

Once during Queen Victoria's reign, she heard that the wife of a common laborer had lost her baby. Having experienced deep sorrow herself, she felt moved to express her sympathy. So she called on the bereaved woman one day and spent some time with her. After she left, the neighbors asked what the queen had said, "Nothing," replied the grieving mother. "She simply put her hands on mine, and we silently wept together."

We read something similar to this in Job 2:11: "Now when Job's three friends heard of all this adversity that had come upon him, each one came from his own place...For they had made an appointment together to come and mourn with him and to comfort him." A long discourse ensued between Job and his "friends"; however, that was no comfort to Job. Their mourning was more comforting than their conversation.

Often we don't know what to say. Saying nothing, with mourning, is far more comforting than saying the wrong thing.

The Bible doesn't tell us just what to say to those in deep sorrow, but it does say, "Rejoice with them that rejoice; weep with them that weep." (Romans 12:15) Participating in their feelings is comforting.

A heartfelt tear can show such love as words can never do. It says, "I feel in part your pain; my heart goes out to you." D.J.D.
