The Ten Commandments of the Devil

2. Thou shalt make for yourself graven images. You may make them in the form of anything you desire. Exodus 20:4, 1 Peter 4:3
3. Thou shalt take the name of the Lord in vain. There are times when you need strong words to express your feelings. Exodus 20:7, Matthew 5:33-37
4. Remember the Lord's Day and use it as you desire. Six days are not enough for you, take seven and use all of them selfishly. Exodus 20:10, Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 16:2
5. Honor your father and mother as long as they agree with you. Also, forget about them when they are old. Do not burden yourself with them. Exodus 20:12, Ephesians 6:1-3
6. Thou shalt kill. You shall also hate your brother which is as bad as killing. Exodus 20:13, Matthew 5:44
7. Thou shalt commit adultery. You shall live in adultery if it pleases you. You shall also commit adultery in your heart. Think on things that please you. Exodus 20:14, Matthew 5:27-28
8. Thou shalt steal. Surely others are doing the same thing. Cheat others for they would cheat you if they could. Exodus 20:15, Romans 12:17-19
9. Thou shalt bear false witness against thy neighbor. One way that you can fulfill a fleshly longing and ruin the character of others is to gossip. Exodus 20:16, Col. 3:9, Eph. 4:25
10. Thou shalt be a coveter. Anything your neighbor has that you see and like, go after it with all your might. Yes, with all your ability, get it. Exodus 20:17, Ephesians 5:5
