THE BIBLE SAYS...

JOHN THE BAPTIST SAID..."Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" He said this one day when he was baptizing and saw Jesus coming toward him. John was the prophet, who had been sent to "make straight the way for the Lord," and to reveal Jesus to Israel. Out of the many names and descriptions with which he could have called Jesus, he chose to call him Lamb of God. One reason he might have chosen this name is because the Jews were very familiar with the lamb being the animal of the altar. The lamb was known to them for the many and great instances found in the Old Testament.

The first and most famous of these is the story of Abraham and Isaac. Abraham was told to go up on a mountain and offer Isaac, his only son, as a sacrifice to God (Genesis 22:1-14). This was a test of Abraham's faith. On the way up the mountain, Isaac said to his father, "I see the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the offering?" Abraham simply said, "God will provide." And God did just that and told Abraham to not harm the boy and provided a ram for the offering.

Later, the lamb played a large part in the sacrificial system that was designed to make atonement for sins. God has provided for us a sacrificial lamb to take away our sins. Jesus, the Lamb of God, is our sacrificial lamb. He is our provisional lamb. He is our lamb of atonement. Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world. "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing (Revelation 5:12)."
