THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PAUL SAID... "Continue in the faith, stable and steadfast, not drifting from the hope of the Gospel that you heard" (Colossians 1:23). Drifting is usually not a favorable situation. When a boat is adrift, one of two things has happened. It has either lost the power used to propel the boat, or the ability to pilot the boat has been lost or disabled. When adrift, the boat is subject to the waves and the winds of the sea with no guidance or direction.

I think of a boat that is adrift, when I consider Paul's mention of drifting away from the hope of the Gospel. For the most part, Christians do not lose their faith and or quit following Jesus in a single moment. Usually, this happens slowly, over time and often unintentionally. Spiritual drifting is a slow removal of ourselves from the influence of God and His people. To remain faithful takes intentional effort to keep growing as a child of God and living in a way that is pleasing to Him. It is the hope we have in Christ that is the power that drives us to continually grow closer to God. It is the guidance of God's word that navigates us through this world in a spiritual direction.

Let us examine our lives and ask ourselves if we have started to drift. Are we less interested in God's word than we used to be? Are we less apt to go to God in prayer? Do we find ourselves less eager to be around God's people? Let us be stable and steadfast. Let us live by faith and not by doubt like a wave that is tossed by the wind (James 1:6). We must renew ourselves every day with hope and zeal for the Lord.
