THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID... "What are you seeking (John 1:38)? Jesus asked this question of two men who had just heard John the Baptist say that He was the Lamb of God. After they heard this, Jesus noticed they were following Him. They asked Jesus where He was staying, and they followed Him and stayed with Him until morning. They wanted to know more about Jesus and to spend time with Him.

What a good question. Jesus might ask us this same question. It is interesting at times to place ourselves in scenes from the Bible and wonder what it would be like to encounter Jesus face to face. If we were to see Jesus today and He asked us this question, what would we say? We would probably try to say what we thought He wants to hear. The trouble with that is He already knows what we are thinking and seeking.

I cannot help but think that sometimes Jesus wants to ask us this question: When He sees us in situations we should not be in. When He finds that we have veered off the road and are stuck in a ditch. When He sees us wandering around in the wilderness, hungry and thirsty. He must want to ask us what we are thinking and what we are looking for. It would be prudent to ask ourselves this question. What ARE we looking for? What are we chasing? What are we hoping to find that cannot be found by following and spending time with Jesus? If we are seeking greener pastures, we need to remind ourselves that there are no greener pastures than those our Good Shepherd offers to us. We just need to listen to Him and follow Him wherever He leads us. In doing so, we will find everything we need for life and godliness (2Peter 1:3).
