#### THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID... "May no one ever eat fruit from you again" (Mark 11:14). Jesus said this to a fig tree. When Jesus was walking by, He saw the tree and was hungry. He saw that the tree had leaves and was in season and He assumed it would also have fruit. When he went to the tree and found no fruit, He cursed the tree. Leaves are pretty, but God requires fruit. May we all strive to increase in our usefulness to God. It's not about leaves. It's about fruit.
