THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID... "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." (John 14:27). He said this to His disciples a few hours before He was crucified. Their hearts were troubled. Jesus was attempting to calm their hearts and bolster their faith. Peace is something that we all want. This world is filled with fear, discontentment, uncertainty, and grief. Relief from this chaotic mass of disappointment causes many go to great lengths to find peace.

Our human nature causes us to seek remedies that are offered by the world. Of course, many things in this world that provide certain kinds of peace are given to us through the creation of God. There is something very peaceful about a beautiful sunset or the sound of the waves of a calm ocean. Often, we seek peace from the words of a loved one or from a poet or a particular author. I read discussions about inner peace and peace of mind. I believe this resembles what Jesus was trying to leave with his disciples.

The Apostle Paul calls this the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding. This comes from a close relationship with God and our knowledge of Him and His eternal plans. The reason he calls it a peace which surpasses understanding, is not that we cannot comprehend or attain it. What we cannot understand is that Jesus loves us so much that He gave His life to save us. This true, perfect peace of knowing that our sins can be forgiven, and we can have eternal life, will never be found in anything or anyone else. Paul continues by saying this peace will guard the hearts and the minds of those who belong to Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7).
