#### THE BIBLE SAYS...

THE PSALMIST SAID... "Those who make them are just like them, as are all who trust in them" (Psalm 115:18). The unknown psalmist is speaking about those who create idols. He said about these idols, "They have mouths, but cannot speak, eyes, but cannot see. They have ears, but cannot hear, noses, but cannot smell. They have hands, but cannot feel, feet, but cannot walk." I am reminded of an old saying, "We become what we worship."
