#### THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PAUL SAID... "...He has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors." (2 Corinthians 5:19-20). We understand this teaching, within the context of passage, that anyone who acts on behalf of Christ by carrying His message is an ambassador. That is exactly what an ambassador is - one who is sent as a representative of a sovereign power to a foreign land who then reflects the platform and delivers the message. What is the message of the King we represent? Paul tells us it is reconciliation.

An age-old question is: How do Christians interact with those who do not know Christ? God, in providing an answer to that question, has given us this word-picture to help us understand our role in spreading the gospel. How are we to act in the foreign land that is this world? We are to represent the King carrying with us His message of reconciliation. This reconciliation is made possible by the grace offered by God through the sacrifice of His Son. Paul also refers to himself as a steward of this grace which was given to him. Another word for stewardship is dispensation. This is a similar word-picture shown to us in the Bible. (Ephesians 3:2).

We should view ourselves as Paul viewed himself. In each instance, the ambassador, steward, dispenser, must first be filled with reconciliation and grace. A dispenser must be full of that which is to be dispensed. We, who are in Christ and filled with reconciliation and grace, must be ambassadors for the Lord, sharing His message of reconciliation and dispensing His offering of grace. "Let your speech always be filled with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how to respond to every person" (Colossians 4:6).
