## THE BIBLE SAYS...

JEREMIAH SAID... "No one is like you, O LORD; you are great, and your name is mighty in power." (Jeremiah 10:6). The word omnipotent comes from omni, meaning "all" and potent, meaning "power." As with the attributes of omniscience and omnipresence, it points to the fact that God is infinite. He has all power over all things at all times and in all ways. Nowhere is God's omnipotence seen more clearly than in creation. God said, "Let there be..." and it was so. We must have tools and materials to create; God simply spoke, and by the power of His word, everything was created from nothing (Psalm 33:6).

God's omnipotence extends to governments and leaders as He restrains them or lets them go their way according to His plans and purposes. His power is also unlimited regarding Satan. Satan's attack on Job was limited to only certain actions. He is restrained by God's unlimited power (Job 1:12, 2:6). Jesus reminded Pilate that he had no power over Him unless it had been granted to him by the God of all power.

As God incarnate, Jesus Christ is also omnipotent. His power is seen in the miracles He performed - His numerous healings, the feeding of the five thousand, calming the storm, and the ultimate display of power, raising Lazarus and Jairus's daughter from the dead. Jesus came to destroy death, Satan, and sin. In this, God displayed immeasurable greatness of power toward us. According to His eternal plan of redemption, God, through His Son, demonstrated His power to save us from sin. This gospel message, revealed and offered to all, is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes (Romans 1:16).
