THE BIBLE SAYS...

GOD SAID... "I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me" (2 Corinthians 6:18). One of the greatest blessings of being called a child of God is what comes with being His child: an inheritance. It is amazing enough that we could even be called children of God. To be included in His inheritance is hard to believe and comprehend. But we need to understand the basic truths about God's inheritance.

Who are heirs? As with almost every situation common to man, the heirs are so designated by the one writing the will, the testator. Anyone can certainly make a claim to an inheritance, but if the testator did not designate them as such, the claim is invalid and worthless. In this case, Jesus Christ is the testator. This was an obvious truth used by the writer of the book of Hebrews to make the point about how Jesus was the Mediator of the New Covenant (Hebrews 9:15-17). Apostle Paul clarifies who is an heir in Galatians 3:26-29, where he wrote, "You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise."

What is the Inheritance? Having established God's faithful children as the heirs, this is the next logical question. Jesus said, "Everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life" (Matthew 19:24-29). Eternal life is the inheritance of the children of God. We have a guarantee of this through the Holy Spirit which is made manifest by the abundance of spiritual blessings already experienced in the lives of God's children today (Ephesians 1:3-14).

Don and Gaye Young headed to Houston on Friday for Gaye's tests. Please pray for a safe trip.


Please continue to pray for Brian and Shana's daughter, Bethany, as the time has arrived for her baby to be born!
