THE BIBLE SAYS...

MICAH SAID...“ He has told you what is good and what the LORD requires of you: to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God.” (Micah 6:8). We are taught throughout the Bible to walk with God. There are several people described as “walking with God” beginning with Enoch. Noah is also described as “a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God.” God desires all His children to walk with Him.

One misconception is that walking with God will cause Him to bless us. It is not possible to walk in such a way that causes God to bestow His wonderful blessings on us. The reality is that walking with God is a result of already being blessed. For those who have obeyed the gospel by faith in God and His plan of redemption, have become children of God and are given every blessing that is found in Christ. Because Christians are so bountifully blessed, our natural reaction should be to walk with God.

When the Bible speaks of “walking” it often refers to a lifestyle. We understand in the Bible that we can also walk in the ways of the world, which is the opposite of walking with God. To walk with God means we choose to glorify Him in every way we can, regardless of personal cost. We cannot walk with God and also walk with Satan or with evil people as companions. We can no longer walk in a lifestyle to please ourselves, but only God. And we seek to eliminate from our lives everything that does not enhance our walk with Him. God’s ways and desires must be reflected in our thoughts, our actions, our motivations, and our life choices because we spend so much time with Him. “Can two walk together, except they be agreed” ([Amos 3:3](#)).

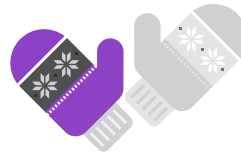
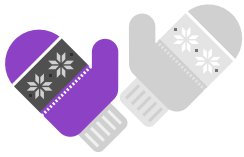
News and Notes
