THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PAUL SAID...“Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!” (Romans 11:33). In the third chapter of Genesis, we read about Eve desiring the wisdom of God. It is clear that this desire was a contributor to her inevitable physical death. Even though God had told her to not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, Satan deceived her, and she did just that. It is interesting to notice that in one verse Satan told her that she would be like God in knowing good and evil and in the next verse she thought what she would receive is wisdom. The tree was not able to provide wisdom and certainly not the wisdom of God. Aptly named, it only provided knowledge of good and evil. And much to their dismay, fear, and confusion, that is what Adam and Eve received.

Christians are encouraged to seek wisdom and to be wise. But the very beginning of wisdom is to fear the Lord rather than to disobey Him as Adam and Eve did. We are told if we lack wisdom, we should ask God. Though God will give wisdom to us generously, let us not be deceived into thinking we can approach the wisdom of God. Paul refers to the wisdom of God as unsearchable. He also calls God's wisdom manifold, describing its immense variety of phases and aspects, its depth and vastness. No person can know the thoughts and wisdom of God. Our efforts should be in growing in wisdom that is provided by God through His written Word. We are encouraged to be wise in what is good and innocent in what is evil (Romans 16:19).
