THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PAUL SAID... "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come" (2 Corinthians 5:17). The word "therefore" refers us back to where Paul tells us that all believers have died with Christ and no longer live for themselves. Common sense would say that becoming a new creature would require the old creature to die. The Bible is replete with discussion of these teachings. Paul said, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). The process of becoming a Christian requires us to completely put away our past of living a life of sin and only living for ourselves. This is described as dying, as if that old person no longer exists. Then we are recreated in our mind and our actions as though we are a new person. This is described as a renewal and a regeneration. The way we think, and act become so different, it is as though we have been born again.

The enactment of this takes place at baptism. Listen to Romans 6:3-4. "Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." This emphasizes three things: To be in Christ one must be baptized into Christ. Baptism is the very act of death to our old life of sin. And we are baptized "in order that" we may be raised up out of baptism to live a new life, just like Christ was raised from the dead. This new creation in Christ is possible only by His own crucifixion and resurrection which offers us forgiveness and salvation. Living this new life in Christ and for Christ is an offering of appreciation for what He has done for us.
