THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID... "For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven (Matthew 5:20). Jesus is instructing people who were entrenched in a culture that was being led by men who were corrupted with self-importance, and self-reliance. He called them hypocrites, blind guides, and white-washed tombs. Jesus' sermon was about His Kingdom that was soon to come. He spoke of things the audience had never before heard or even considered. He wanted to impress upon them that entering the Kingdom would require a change of culture. There would be different attitudes, motives, and conduct. It was not so much about comparing themselves to the scribes and Pharisees as it was about changing their way of life to reflect the goodness of God.

That is the beauty of this transformation. It does not matter what our lives are like prior to becoming a child of God. We can all transform into what He would have us to be. He places His Son in plain view so that we can see how He wants us to be. We see a Jesus that is humble, forgiving, and considerate of others, as opposed to the existing culture of being arrogant and unforgiving with consideration only for themselves. It is the goal of a Christian to be completely conformed into the image of Jesus (Romans 8:29). We are taught to no longer be conformed to the pattern of the world, but to be transformed by the renewing of our minds so we can know God's good, pleasing, and perfect will (Romans 12:2). The Lord's church are those who love Him above all things, placing Him first in their lives, renouncing the culture of the world, and transforming into the likeness of Jesus.
