#### THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID..."All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth" (Matthew 28:18). This is one of the last things Jesus said while He was physically with His disciples. He had said similar things before, but this was different. At this point in time Jesus had been resurrected from the dead. Jesus' work on earth was complete. He had come to redeem humankind which required Him to die on the cross for the sins of the world. Even though all things had already been handed over to Him (Matthew 11:27), if He had not risen, He would no longer have this authority. To resume His rightful place of authority He had to live again.

Now, Jesus is at the right hand of God, which is the place of ultimate authority. The resurrection of Jesus restored Him to His rightful place of triumphant authority over all things. And from there He works out His saving purposes in the world. He has all authority over all other authority and power and dominion and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come, (Ephesians 1:21). This does not sound like the position of someone who is dead. His resurrection is the Power of God's plan of redemption. His power and authority will never fall, and His cause will never fail.

The hope that we can be certain of is that we serve a risen savior. He cannot fail. Sin and death and hell and evil and Satan cannot defeat His purposes. He, by His resurrection, has defeated all these things. These eternal words Jesus said in Matthew 28 were what gave His apostles the power and confidence to conduct the work that He left for them to do. And they are the promise that causes us to believe in and follow Jesus. He then said to them, "And surely I will be with you always, to the very end of the age."
