THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PETER SAID...“The day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night” (2 Peter 3:10). The mention of the day of the Lord throughout the Bible is an interesting study. The phrase “day of the LORD” is noted in thirty verses. The concept is first expressed in the Old Testament prophets, where it represents a day of judgment, separation, and testing. It consistently exposes those who lack real trust in God and becomes the impetus to their destruction, physically or spiritually. But it also serves as a day of deliverance and identification for the faithful few true followers of God. The specific circumstances vary greatly. There was the Assyrian invasion, the Babylonian captivity, and a locust plague, and others. These days are described as great and magnificent, cruel with wrath and fierce anger, and full of vengeance. However different they may be, each event serves to divide the unfaithful from the faithful.

There are those who have referred to modern day disasters, calamities, and pandemics as a day of the Lord. Only God can reveal what circumstances truly serve as divine efforts to convince people to turn from their wicked ways and return to Him. However, when these things occur, they should remind us to grow ever closer to God. Regardless of the events in the world around us, we are to serve, worship, love, and sacrifice. We can be certain that one of “these days” is still to come. This one will be different because when Jesus returns, opportunities to repent and reform will be gone. Peter continues in 2 Peter 3, “The heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives...”
