THE BIBLE SAYS...

JESUS SAID... "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10). Jesus makes the claim that His reason for coming to this world was to seek and save the lost. He said these words to Zacchaeus, who was a tax collector and known to be a sinner. Zacchaeus pled his case and repented of anything he had ever done wrong. Jesus' response seemed to say, "You are just who I am looking for." Jesus went to his house and ate with him. Jesus was ridiculed for being a guest of a sinner.

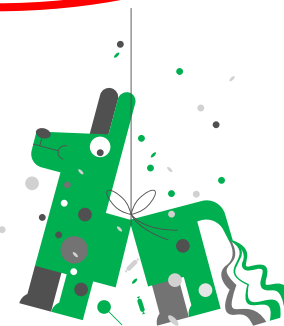
On another occasion, in Luke 15, while Jesus was teaching, tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Him. And the Pharisees and scribes were complaining, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them!" Jesus then told a parable teaching about His desire to seek and save those who are lost.

Again, in Mark 2, Jesus called Levi to follow Him. He ended up at Levi's home. There were many tax collectors and sinners eating with Him and His disciples. Once again, He was reprimanded for associating with these kinds of people. On hearing this, Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

Jesus loves those who are His faithful followers. However, they are not as much in need of His attention as are those who are sinful and are lost. True followers of Christ will be found walking in His footsteps and imitating His actions. Disciples of one whose self-proclaimed purpose is to seek and to save the lost will find themselves doing just as He did. Jesus sought out the lost, received them, ate with them, taught them, and showed them the way to salvation.
