## THE BIBLE SAYS...

GOD SAID...“I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions, for My own sake, and remembers your sins no more” (Isaiah 43:25). The exact words are not in the Bible, but we have a way of saying, “forgive and forget.” It is a fallacy that we are commanded to follow this concept. Any attempt of ours to forgive and forget always comes up a little short. One might honestly admit that an offense is truly forgiven and yet there will be times when something will jog their memory of the offense.

It is unfortunate that we humans do not have the ability to fully forget transgressions against us. But I believe the understanding of this should trigger two important considerations. First, it helps us to acknowledge and appreciate the incomprehensible nature of our God that allows Him to completely blot out transgressions from memory. Secondly, it should prompt us to seek out just what is our responsibility regarding forgiveness, as children and imitators of God. This may raise a few questions. Apostle Peter once asked such a question of Jesus. He responded in a way that required much more than Peter had prepared to do (Matthew 18:21-22).

Let us always be in awe of and utterly thankful for the forgiving and forgetting nature of God, remembering the price of redemption Jesus paid which allows us to be forgivable at all. And when we seek smooth answers that might limit how forgiving God wants us to be, we should contemplate the words of Jesus, “If you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins” (Matthew 6:15). In a nutshell...If we are looking for loopholes, we are most likely falling short of our duty to forgive.

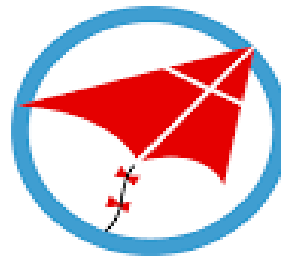
