## THE BIBLE SAYS...

KING SOLOMON SAID... "Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain" (Psalm 127:1). This verse reveals the key to success in any endeavor and God's absolute sovereignty. In any activity, we need God's blessing. All that we accomplish in life will be for naught if the Lord is not in it. We can "build," and we can "watch," but it is the Lord who gives success.

The clause "unless the Lord builds" of course, does not imply that the Lord has a hammer and nails and is performing construction work. Rather, it speaks metaphorically of the Lord's direct involvement in our lives. In the Bible, the Hebrew word for "house," literally refers to temples, palaces, and homes, and figuratively, to households, families, and the structure of a person's life. It not only represents a dwelling place but also one's self-identity, security, and place in this world. We cannot reasonably hope to have a fulfilling, truly successful life without our heavenly Father's help, guidance, and protection over our "house."

No matter how skilled or diligent the worker may be, "the work of the builders is wasted" unless the Lord builds the "house." God is the master carpenter of our lives. He is the source of wisdom, which is the most valuable building material. "By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established; through knowledge its rooms are filled with rare and beautiful treasures" (Proverbs 24:3-4). The Lord has a plan for us, and we have the responsibility to cooperate in that plan. It is not that the builders of the "house" stop working, but they recognize the need for God's direction and blessing in their efforts. Trying to accomplish anything without God's blessing and apart from His wisdom, is foolish.
