THE BIBLE SAYS...

APOSTLE PETER SAID..."You yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house" (1 Peter 2:5). Peter explains that they are individually living stones, like Jesus, the living cornerstone, and together these stones are being built into a house. By using the word spiritual, Peter helps us know he is not talking about a physical house; rather, God is building something spiritual. In Romans 8:9, Paul introduces a concept similar to Peter's assertion that God's people are being built up as a spiritual house. Paul also illustrates the members of God's family being built together into a dwelling place for the Lord (Ephesians 2:21).

In the Old Testament, the temple was designed to be that place where God would meet humanity. It was the house of God. Today, God's people are built into a house which is His dwelling place through His Spirit. Because God is Spirit, it makes perfect sense that His dwelling would be a spiritual dwelling. He dwells in His people collectively in this spiritual temple also described as the body of or the church of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-14, Ephesians 1:22-23). In Christ is where God meets His people, His family.

The Bible encourages us to be careful how we build this house of God. We must build by the blueprint God has laid out for us (1 Corinthians 3:9-17). We must not build on any other foundation but Jesus and with any other blueprint but God's. We too should keep His house pure from false doctrine and sin. It matters what we do in our worship to God. It also matters what we do with our bodies. When we understand that we are designed as a spiritual house in which God lives, then we understand this house must be kept pure, where worshipping and serving God is done in a manner which pleases Him.
