THE BIBLE SAYS...

THE HEBREW WRITER SAID..."Let us hold on tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise" (Hebrews 10:23). In the early 2000s, "Everest: Beyond the Limit" was released on the Discovery Channel. This documentary follows a group of individuals as they make the astonishing trek up the 29,000-foot mountain. When the team neared the summit, they were forced to hold on to a rope that guided them through incredibly treacherous weather. The wind was gusting, the snow was blinding, and the oxygen was thin. Summiting the mountain became increasingly more difficult with each step they took.

The writer uses the words "hold on" or "hold fast" several times in his exhortation to the Hebrews. As we face the trials and temptations of this world, we must hold on to the security rope that is the hope we have been given in Christ. Hebrews 3:14 says to hold firmly to the very end. What is it that gives us the fortitude to continue fighting these battles that we face? It is the faithfulness of God. God can be trusted to keep His promises. We can be certain that reaching the summit is worth enduring the treacherous climb because God is faithful and gave His Son's life to secure this promise.

Are you holding on? Has your grip loosened over the years? Have you already let go? There is no debate that the trek is difficult. Life is ruthless and full of tragedy, discouragement, and ailment. One thing we know about Everest is that a climber never makes the climb alone. It is always a group effort, leaning on one another for assistance, support, and encouragement. Christians must draw upon the strength of the Lord's church and together dig our boots into the never-failing promises of God. And hold fast to the rope of eternal hope. Never giving up. Never letting go.
