Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:16

THE BIBLE SAYS...

GOD SAID..."And you shall put the mercy seat on the top of the ark of the covenant. There I will meet with you...and I will speak with you" (Exodus 25:21-22). God is directing His people in the details of the order and function of the tabernacle. The tabernacle was the portable sanctuary where God dwelt in the midst of His people from the time of their wandering in the wilderness to the building of the temple in Jerusalem. Within the most holy place in the tabernacle was the ark of the covenant. Covering the ark was the mercy seat. This is where Almighty God would sit and dispense mercy when the blood of an atoning sacrifice was sprinkled there.

The Greek word for "mercy seat" in Hebrews 9:5 is hilasterion, which means "propitiation," or "that which makes expiation." It carries the idea of the removal of sin. What is the significance of this? In the New Testament, Christ Himself is designated as our "propitiation." Paul explains in Romans 3:24-25, "We are being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood."

What Paul is teaching here is that Jesus is the "covering" for sin. He is now the mercy seat of the new covenant. The mercy seat of old was a foreshadowing and precursor to the perfect mercy seat that is Jesus. By means of His death, and our response to the call of Christ, all our sins are "covered." In Christ Jesus is where God's people now meet with God and where God speaks to us. It is through Christ Jesus that God offers mercy for our sins. Because of the completed redeeming work of Jesus, we can now approach God's throne of grace with confidence (Hebrews 4:16)
