## THE BIBLE SAYS...

KING SOLOMON SAID..."Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you. Ponder the path of your feet; then all your ways will be sure" (Proverbs 4:25-26). I have only been to the beach a couple of times. I never acquired the basic knowledge about swimming in the ocean. I do know that when you are out in the water, playing around in the waves, the current imperceptibly moves you around. I remember being in the ocean, then looking up and not recognizing anything in front of me. The only way to prevent that drift from happening is to find a landmark on the beach and consistently glance at it.

In the same way, Solomon is telling us that we must keep our eyes fixed on what is before us if we are going to stay on the path of righteousness. We should think carefully about the path on which our feet are taking us as we keep our gaze fixed on what is ahead. Where we look makes all the difference. We must have direction in our lives if we are going to keep ourselves from drifting toward sin.

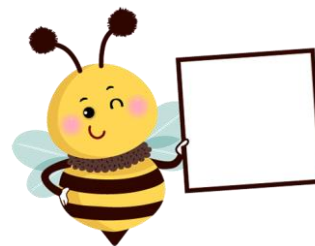

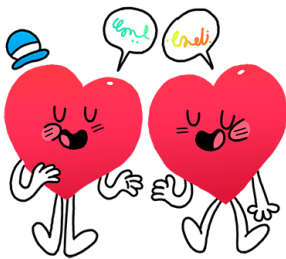
