The Bible Says... Renew Your Mind

Apostle Paul said, "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind" (Romans 12:2). Paul calls on Christians to be transformed. This is the same word from which we get metamorphosis, a term that refers to the changing of a caterpillar into a butterfly. So, in effect, he directs us to be changed from one form into another.

After instructing us to "be changed," Paul then reveals how this transformation occurs. For us to change our lives, we first must renew our minds.

It is obvious that every thought we have comes from the mind. But we need to realize that every action we take and every word we say also comes from the mind. Every good deed, as does every bad deed, originates in the mind. Renewing the mind is something that is an on-going process. We must constantly give attention to this because there are so many things of the world which may confuse and distract our minds from things which are pleasing to God. Sinful pleasures, money and materialism, relationship problems, or just the daily cares of life can become the main occupation of our minds. These thoughts then will create corresponding actions.

If there are things we want to change about our personal conduct and character, we must renew our minds. Changing bad habits into good habits takes a change of the mind. Transformation will not happen overnight and begins with a decision to align our minds with what pleases God. Philippians 4:8 says, "Fix your minds on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise." The Bible promises this renewal of our minds will transform our lives.
