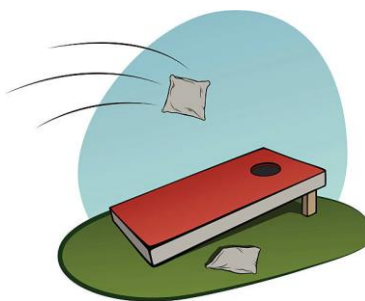

## The Bible Says... Enter The Narrow Gate

Jesus said, "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it" (Matthew 7:13-14). Jesus uses a metaphor of two roads to illustrate the choice between living a godly life and a worldly life. Jesus calls godly living that leads to life a narrow road. The ethical demands of God's kingdom are explicit and uncompromising. Jesus refers to worldly living that leads to destruction as a broad road because godlessness and unrighteousness have countless manifestations.

The godly way is narrow for three reasons: There is only one way to heaven which is through Jesus (John 14:6, Acts 4:12). It is a more challenging path to travel through this world. And the number of people who choose that road are few. The worldly way is broad for the opposite reasons: All other travel, which is not through Christ, go down this path. It is a path chosen for its less demanding terrain. And the number of people who choose the way of the world will be many.

The easy way is to choose the path of comfort and least resistance. For most people this is to follow their own desires rather than those of God; to reject the call of Jesus and replace His morals with their own self-made regulations. But even though there is a cost of certain difficulties while in this world, choosing the narrow road and rejecting the broad one is worthwhile. The narrow road is the only one that leads to eternal life with God.
