The Bible Says... There Is A Cloud Of Witnesses

The Hebrews writer said, "...we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses..." (Hebrews 12:1). Some see in this passage the idea that people who have passed from this life may be able to see us and our activities. As much as we might like the notion that we are being observed by our departed loved ones, that is not what this verse teaches. Some may point to the rich man's mention of his brothers in Luke 16:28 as proof that departed souls can see events on earth. However, the passage never says that he could see his brothers or knew of their activities. Others might mention Revelation 6:10 as a proof text. This is when the faithful martyrs call for God to avenge their deaths. Again, this passage says nothing about the martyrs seeing these people still on earth.

The Bible does not specifically say that departed Christians cannot see us, so we must not be dogmatic about it. Though, it is unlikely. They will be occupied with wonderful things such as worshiping God and enjoying the glories of eternal salvation. John's vision gives us a glimpse of part of God's reward for the Faithful. "God will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away" (Revelation 21:4). This promise would shelter us from seeing activities on earth that would upset us. It most likely will also shelter us from knowing other things that would cause us to cry or mourn such as remembering our own difficult lives on earth, or even knowing who has not received the reward of eternal life. Whether they see us or not, we are not running our race for them. We are not running for their approval, but for the commendation of God.
