The Bible Says... Be Faithful

The Hebrews writer said, "But without faith it is impossible to please God" (Hebrews 11:6). When studying faith, it is important to understand that the scriptures speak of faith in various ways. The term faith can take on different meaning, depending on the context in which it is used. The beginning of faith is that we believe in God. The scriptures also teach us to have faith in Jesus and that He is the son of God.

Jude wrote, "...I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3). Jude spoke of "the faith" having been "delivered." He is speaking about the body of teaching in God's Word upon which one's faith is based. "The faith," in this context can be used interchangeably with "the gospel" (Philippians 1:16). To believe in the faith is to believe in the saving power of the gospel that was delivered to us through the scriptures. When this faith is developed, a person must decide to walk by faith, meaning to live our lives according to the teachings of the faith that we have received.

Finally, the Apostle Paul said, "The righteous live by faith." To "live by faith" is a culmination of all things concerning faith. We must believe in God and His promises. We must believe in Jesus Christ as God's son and our savior. We must adhere to the faith and live a life that is pleasing to God. And we must be faithful in our walk with God. Faithfulness speaks to our endurance to live by faith, always, and in every situation. Jesus instructed, "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life" (Revelation 2:10). Let us decide to give proper attention to our faith. Let us nurture it through our study of the teachings of the faith, applying those teachings properly to our lives, faithfully.
