The Bible Says... Be Strong In The Lord

Apostle Paul said, "Be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power" (Ephesians 6:10). Paul had been teaching the Ephesians about the high calling of God in Christ Jesus and the life that flows from it. He outlined the standards of this life for believers individually, and within the Lord's church. Paul reminded believers that the Christian life means participation in a spiritual battle. In this battle against the powers of darkness, they cannot endure without the power of God. To be strong in the Lord and the power of His might is vital to living a victorious Christian life.

It is important to understand that in spiritual battle we have no way to strengthen ourselves. We only receive strength from the Lord. Only when our lives are positioned in the Lord, in union with Him, do we possess the appropriate power to overcome the enemy. Jesus said, "Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine" (John 15:4). The believer's empowerment comes from being in Jesus – that is in His body, His church. In the Lord, He will strengthen us with everything we need for any task.

When Paul encourages believers to be strong in the Lord, he is calling them to faithfulness—to abide in Christ, to trust in the Lord's power, and to diligently stand against the devil's schemes. Our faith in the Lord is strongest when we operate in the realm of human weakness. When we stop relying on our own strength, ability, and prowess, we begin to make room for God to strengthen us with His mighty power. Paul said, "I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Corinthians12:9-10).
