The Bible Says... God Loves Zion

A Psalmist said, "He has set His foundation on the holy mountain; the LORD loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob. Glorious things are said of you, O city of God" (Psalm 87:1-3). According to this passage, Zion is synonymous with the city of God, and it is a place that God loves. Zion was first used as a name for Jerusalem. Mount Zion is the high hill, just outside the city, on which David built a citadel. The word Zion occurs over 150 times in the Bible. The word means "fortification" and has the idea of being "raised up" as a "monument." Zion is described both as the city of David and the city of God. As the Bible progresses, the word Zion expands in scope and takes on an additional, spiritual meaning.

When Solomon built the , the meaning of Zion expanded to include the temple area. It was used in the Old Testament as a name for the city of Jerusalem, the land of Judah, and the nation of Israel as a whole. Zion also refers figuratively to Israel as the people of God. This spiritually figurative tone continues in the New Testament. Zion refers to God's spiritual kingdom. The writer of Hebrews implies that Christians have not come to Mount Sinai, but "to Mount Zion, the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God" (Hebrews 12:22). The Hebrews writer continues by synonymously adding to this list "the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven." Peter, quoting Isaiah 28:16, refers to Christ as the Cornerstone of Zion, referring to the assembly or the church of God's people (1 Peter 2:6). The Bible, with timeless literary brilliance, unquestionably portrays Zion as the glorious, physical, and now spiritual dwelling place of God's people. God's love of Zion is in virtue of His love for His people.

Activities


Today is potluck and early service. The AIMers will be eating with us. Please join us!
