The Bible Says

Apostle Paul said, "One person esteems one day as better than another, while another esteems all days alike...For we don't live for ourselves or die for ourselves" (Romans 14:5,7). Christmas is an amazing time of year. It seems more like a season than a day. Unfortunately, "Christianity and Christmas" is a combination that causes differences of opinion. The original ideas that December 25 is Jesus' birthday came from speculative calculations and traditions that are not supported in the Bible. The truth is we do not know what season of the year or even the exact year when Jesus was born. With all the details that are in the Bible concerning the birth of Christ, it makes us wonder why the date is not made clear. The obvious answer is that the recorded details are important and significant, and the date is not. Our calendars have other dates on which we celebrate certain events that have little to do with the events themselves.

In this vein, I will offer three things we should be reminded of. First, what Paul is telling us in Romans 14 is that whichever view we hold, we do not have the liberty to bind others to it. Our love for one another should far outweigh any views held in matters such as this. Verse 1 tells us to not argue over opinions. Verse 23 tells Christians to not do things that violate their consciences. Second, in the grand scheme of God's ways, it does not matter on which day Jesus was born. What matters is that He was born, which is worthy of celebration every day. Third, Christmas is a time where there is an amplified focus on Christ, an abundance of good cheer and kindness toward others, and opportunity to spend time with family and loved ones. Appreciate and enjoy the season!
