The Bible Says

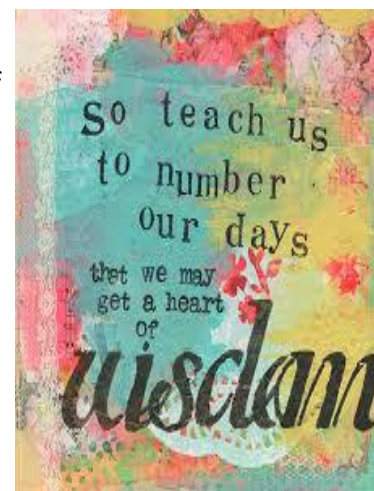
Moses said, "Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom" (Psalm 90:12). And so it is again that the calendar is about to flip into another year. For many, this time of year just creates another holiday. For others, it is a time of deep reflection, both on the past year and on the one ahead. I believe Moses is asking God to help him be aware of the passing of time. Time is fleeting and days of gaining wisdom are passing by. Time is a gift from God. It is important to consider how we are using this gift of time.

Though setting goals for a new year is not required for a Christian, but it is a sign that we are intentional about glorifying God. How have we used our time this past year. Have we been glorifying God or ourselves. Have we been living a life that is pleasing to God or to ourselves and others. We may not be in the habit of setting goals for ourselves, but God does. Paul calls this the high calling of God. He is less concerned with the physical and worldly goals we might set for ourselves. He is more interested in the spiritual ones.

If we were to write down some goals for next year, we should start with the heart. Moses was seeking to gain a heart of wisdom. David was seeking a pure heart, Psalm 51:10. And had stored up the Word of God on His heart, Psalm 119:11. Proverbs 27:19 says, "As water reflects the face, so one's life reflects the heart." God said, "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart" (Jeremiah 29:13). So, as we contemplate some things we can improve on to draw us nearer to God in the upcoming year, let us start with the heart.
