Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14

The Bible Says

Jesus said, "God is spirit, and His worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24). Jesus said this to a woman who thought physical locale has a bearing on proper worship of God, as in the Old Testament. The fact that God is spirit simply means that God the Father does not have a human body. God the Son came to earth in human form, but God the Father did not. Numbers 23:19 emphasizes God's spiritual nature by contrasting Him with mortal men, "God is not human, that He should lie, not a human being, that He should change His mind."

The Bible sometimes speaks of God as if He has a body. It mentions His hands, eyes, ears, mouth, and arms. These are examples of anthropomorphism. This is a way of describing God in human and personal terms so that we can better understand how we can interact with Him. But the Bible clearly substantiates that He is spirit, invisible and immortal. Even though God is spirit, He is also a living, personal being. We can have a relationship with Him: sing to Him, pray to Him, and know that He is near, and that He hears us and loves us.

Philosophically, God must be a spirit in order to be infinite. Also, if God were confined to a physical body, He could not be omnipresent. God the Father is not limited to the dimensional restrictions of created things but can exist in all places at one time. God is the uncreated First Cause that is the power behind all other beings. Jesus makes the connection between God being spirit and worshiping Him in spirit. With the coming of Christ, our worship is now a matter of the heart and of the mind, rather than external actions, limited by physical locales, man-made traditions, and rituals.
