The Bible Says

The Hebrew writer said, "We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure" (Hebrews 6:19). In a few verses, he intends to instill steadfast hope in his readers to keep them from drifting about aimlessly through the Christian life. He does so by identifying three wholly reliable sources of hope as an anchor for the soul: God's Word, God's Character, and God's Son. The Lord not only gives us the promise of salvation and eternal life, but He reinforces it by binding Himself with an oath so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that He would never change His mind. God's Word and nature are rock solid. He is trustworthy, and it is impossible for God to lie. The dependability of God's promise and His Character allows us to confidently take hold of the hope set before us and be greatly encouraged in our faith. God's Son, our High Priest, has entered God's inner sanctuary as a forerunner for us.

We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. The anchor has been a symbol of hope among Christians since the days of the early church. The anchor metaphor emphasizes the stability and safety of Christ as our hope. A ship's anchor allows a ship to remain fixed and unmoving regardless of the conditions at sea. Our hope in Jesus Christ keeps us from becoming like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. Just as an anchor stops a ship from drifting with the winds and currents, Christians, by keeping their eyes on the hope that is reserved for us in heaven, prevents our souls from wavering and wandering in times of pressure, temptation, trial, and turmoil. This anchor of hope holds us steady in this life and secure in our future because it is promised in the Word of God, upon the Character of God, and through the redeeming work of God's Son.
