The Bible Says

Apostle Paul said, "Pray continually" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). For the Christian, praying is supposed to be like breathing, easier to do than to not. We pray for a variety of reasons. For one thing, prayer is a form of serving God and obeying Him. We pray because God commands us to pray. Prayer is exemplified for us by Christ. If Jesus thought it was worthwhile to pray, so should we. Another reason to pray is that God intends prayer to be the means of obtaining His will in our lives. We pray in preparation for major decisions, to gain strength to overcome temptation, and to be able to encourage and strengthen others.

We also come to God with our specific requests, and we have God's promise that our prayers are not in vain. He has promised that when we ask for things that are in accordance with His will, He will give us what we ask for. Sometimes He delays His answers according to His wisdom. In these situations, we are to be diligent and persistent in prayer. Other times God's answer is "no." This may leave us confused but should lead us to further prayer to be able to discern His will and to align our will with His. Prayer is not to get God to do our will on earth, but rather to get God's will done on earth.

Like many other things Christians do, we pray to demonstrate our faith in God. It is our means of "plugging into" God's power, which is our means of defeating Satan and his army that we are powerless to overcome by ourselves. Therefore, may God find us often before His throne in prayer. May we glorify His name in our lives as we believe in Him enough to come to Him continually in prayer. A lack of prayer demonstrates a lack of faith and a lack of trust in God's Word. Remember, all prayers un-prayed will certainly be prayers unanswered.
