The Bible Says

King Solomon said, "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding" (Proverbs 9:10). For the unbeliever, the fear of God is the fear of the judgment of God and eternal death, which is eternal separation from Him. For the believer, the fear of God is something much different. In short, the believer's fear is a reverence for God. It is the believer who has received a kingdom that cannot be shaken in Hebrews 12:28-29, which continues to say that we then should "be thankful, and worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, because God is a consuming fire." The Christian should not be afraid of God, because nothing can separate us from His love (Romans 8:38-39). The fear of God is when a believer is in this intimate relationship with God and at the same time knows that He is a consuming fire when it comes to sin, unholiness, and rebellion.

This is exactly what Solomon is saying. When our knowledge of God leads us to this understanding, we are in the beginnings of true wisdom. The more we recognize God for who He is, the more we will grow in wisdom. The wise and understanding Christian will factor God into every aspect of life. Those who fear the Lord have continual awareness of Him, deep reverence for Him, and sincere commitment to obey Him. Without the fear of the Lord, we make decisions and live our lives based on our faulty human wisdom and understanding. Yet, when we incorporate the fear of the Lord into every moment of our lives, we make decisions based upon His approval and live in a manner that is pleasing to Him.
