The Bible Says

Apostle Paul said, "His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known..." (Ephesians 3:10). In the midst of a remarkable teaching about the Gospel of Christ, Paul uses a unique adjective to describe God's wisdom. The original word, πολυποίκιλος (polupoikilos), only used once in the Bible, is here translated manifold. The original meaning is "many and varied; having many features and forms; wrought in various colors; diversified, intricate, iridescent, complex, many-sided." The translators were most-certainly grasping for a word to capture the complexity of this extraordinary adjective. It is an attempt to describe the mind of God as He eternally purposed His plan of salvation, which was accomplished through Christ Jesus Our Lord (Ephesians 3:11).

For the earliest Christians, the secret mystery of universal salvation began to be revealed through the Lord's church. Even "the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places" were learning about it for the first time. Questions arose concerning the "How" and the "Why" of such an extraordinary offer of the grace of God. To the Romans, Paul declared, "Oh, how great are God's riches and wisdom and knowledge! How impossible it is for us to understand His decisions and His ways" (Romans 11:33). Though it is impossible to understand, we experience God's manifold wisdom in His church, believers who have heard and obeyed the "good news" of the Gospel. They are now a perfect blend of diversity and harmony. The many features and forms, and colors of fellowship and unity reflect and reveal the manifold wisdom of God. May Christians everywhere never underestimate the wisdom of God or underappreciate His gracious offer of salvation, in Christ.
