The Bible Says

Apostle Paul said, "...so that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God" (Ephesians 3:19). In the letter Paul wrote to these Christians, these are the final words of a prayer that he prayed for them. In that prayer he mentions that they receive power from the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. And that Christ dwells in their hearts. Earlier in this letter, he speaks about how they are a dwelling place for God. Undoubtedly, the profound concept that is the "fullness of God" subsumes these foundational truths. Paul is teaching that God's People are an embodiment of the completeness of the Godhead. This would include the boundless richness of God's nature, encompassing His love, holiness, wisdom, and power. It refers to the complete and infinite presence of God, which is fully revealed in Jesus Christ.

In Colossians 1:19, the Apostle Paul states that, God was pleased to have all His fullness dwell in His Son. Jesus was the perfect embodiment of God's fullness on earth. We are told in 1 John 2:6 that we are to walk in the same way that Jesus did. Ephesians 5:1 says that we should be imitators of God. For Christians, the fullness of God is not just an abstract idea; it is a living reality. We are to take on the nature of and reflect the glory of God. This fullness is experienced through a personal relationship with God, and by living according to the Holy Spirit, which transforms us into the image of Christ. The fullness of God is not a future promise but a present reality. Christians are called to live in this fullness now, allowing God's presence to shape and direct every aspect of their lives.
