7he Bible Says

John the Baptist said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29)! This was John's way of introducing Jesus to the disciples. At the same time, he was describing Jesus' purpose while on earth. That was to seek and save those who were lost. He was referring to Jesus as the perfect and ultimate sacrifice for sin. The sacrifice of lambs played a significant role in the Jewish religious life and sacrificial system. When John the Baptist referred to Jesus as the "Lamb of God," the Jews who heard this might have immediately thought of the sacrificial Passover lamb used in the yearly Passover feast or of the daily sacrifice at the temple in Jerusalem where a lamb was sacrificed for the sins of the people.

While the idea of a sacrificial system might seem strange to us today, the concept of payment or restitution is still one we can easily understand. We know that the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23) and that our sin separates us from God. Therefore, the only hope we have, is for God to provide a way for us to be reconciled to Himself. That is what He did by sending His Son, Jesus Christ to die on the cross. It is through His death on the cross as God's perfect sacrifice for sin that we can now have eternal salvation if we believe in Him. God Himself has provided the final offering that atones for our sin; the "Lamb of God." This is part of the glorious, good news of the gospel. "For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect" (1 Peter 1:18-19).
