The Bible Says

Apostle Paul said, "…run with patience the race that is set before you" (Hebrews 12:1). When everything is going our way, patience is easy to demonstrate. The true test of patience comes when our rights are violated—when another car cuts us off in traffic; when we are treated unfairly; when our coworker derides our faith. Some people think they have a right to get upset in the face of irritations and trials. The Bible, however, says that patience is a fruit of the Spirit and should be produced in all followers of Christ. The word in Hebrews 12:1, translated "patience" means "endurance." A Christian runs the race patiently by persevering through difficulties. In the Bible, patience is persevering towards a goal, bearing with one another, enduring trials, expectantly waiting for a promise to be fulfilled.

Patience does not develop overnight. God's power and goodness are crucial to the development of patience. James 1:3-4 encourages us to know that trials are God's way of perfecting our patience. Our patience is further developed and strengthened by resting in God's perfect will and timing. We see in the Bible many examples of those whose patience characterized their walk with God. How do we display the patience that is characteristic of Christ? First, we thank God, instead of asking Him, "Why Me?" Second, we seek His purposes, which is often that we grow in faith. Third, we remember His promises. The next time we are in a traffic jam, betrayed by a friend, or irritated by someone, how will we respond? The natural response is impatience which leads to stress, anger, and frustration. Instead, we have the Lord's strength to respond with patience and in complete trust in the Father's power and purpose.
