“Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:12

THE BIBLE SAYS

Isaiah said, “Just as there were many who were appalled at Him—His appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any man and his form marred beyond human likeness” (Hebrews 52:4). Jesus suffered severely throughout His trials, torture, and crucifixion. His suffering was not only physical but also emotional. In Matthew 26:56 all the disciples deserted Him and fled. His suffering was spiritual: “God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us” (2 Corinthians 5:21). Jesus had the weight of the sins of the entire world on Him. It was our sin that caused Jesus to cry out, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” (Matthew 27:46).

Jesus told His disciples the Son of Man must suffer many things, and He must be killed. Note the word *must*—He must suffer, and He must be killed. The suffering of Christ was God's plan for the salvation of the world. Why did Jesus have to suffer so badly? Jesus had to suffer because suffering is part of sacrifice, and Jesus was “the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!” (John 1:29). Jesus' physical torture became a part of the payment required for our sins.

Jesus' suffering on the cross showed the devastating nature of sin, the wrath of God, the cruelty of humanity, and the hatred of Satan. At Calvary, humankind was allowed to do his worst to the Son of Man as He became the Redeemer of all. Satan may have thought he had won a great victory, but it was through the cross that the Son of God triumphed over Satan, sin, and death. Jesus suffered and died to secure salvation for all who would believe. There was no other way for us to be saved.
