THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation" (Ephesians 1:13). The truth of the gospel is the good news that God had a plan, before time began, to save sinners. Man is by nature sinful, therefore separated from God, with no hope of remedying that situation. But God, by His power and mercy, provided the means of our salvation, the gospel. Gospel has become synonymous with truth. The gospel is truth. A common saying people use is, "It's the gospel truth," qualifying just how truthful their words are.

The word "gospel" literally means "good news." But to truly comprehend how good this news is, we must first understand the bad news. As a result of the fall of humankind in the Garden of Eden, the Bible said that every part of people—the mind, will, emotions and flesh—have been corrupted by sin. God has declared that the consequence of this sin is eternal punishment. Since all have sinned (Romans 3:23) this is bad news and becomes for us a sin problem.

But God, through the gospel, by His grace, has provided the solution to the problem. His name is Jesus—who came to pay the penalty for our sin by His sacrifice on the cross. Paul explained it this way: The Gospel is the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. Our response to the gospel is to be crucified with Christ to our sinful nature, and buried in baptism into Christ's death, and then resurrected with Him to a new life (1 Corinthians 15:3-4, Romans 6:2-8). Paul tells us to "hold firmly" to this true saving gospel because any variation is false and "no gospel at all." Have you ever heard the whole truth of the gospel? Have you ever responded to this revealed gospel truth?
