THE BIBLE SAYS

Jesus said, "I am the way" (John 14:6). Such an exclusive statement may confuse, surprise, or even offend some readers, but it is true, nonetheless. The Bible teaches that there is no other way to salvation than through Jesus Christ. In this same passage, Jesus continued, "No one comes to the Father except through me." He is not *a* way, as in one of many. He is *the* way, as in the one and only. No one, regardless of reputation, achievement, personal holiness, can come to God the Father except through Jesus.

Jesus is the only way to heaven for several reasons. He is the only way *to* heaven because He is the only one who came *from* heaven (John 3:13). Jesus was "chosen by God" to be the Savior (1 Peter 2:4). He is the only perfect sacrifice for sin (1 John 2:2). He is the only man to have conquered death forever (Hebrews 2:14-15). The apostles' preaching focused on Jesus Christ and His death and resurrection. Peter clearly proclaimed Jesus as the only way to heaven: "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

It is important that we understand this and react to it. We most often connect the word salvation to heaven or eternal life. We like to speak of things we are saved to and not so much of what we are saved from. There are only two destinations after we pass from this earth. Since there is eternal life, there is also eternal death. The Bible calls this eternal punishment, eternal fire, a place of torment, and hell. This is a place from where we must be saved! The only way to this salvation is in Jesus Christ. When so many of Jesus' followers were turning away from His teachings, Jesus asked His twelve apostles if they wanted to leave as well. Peter simply answered, "Lord, to whom shall we go?"
